
... that faithful SFAC member up in Victoria, B.C., Arnie Krenn, had a stroke in early November but is recovering well.

The Golden Age of the Accordion

Remember that great book, co-edited by the late Eddie Chavez and Ron Flynn (with a lot of help from our own Vince Cirelli)? Well, Edwin Davison

(flynnpub@earthlink.net) can ship five (5) books in a single box by "flat rate" priority mail for only \$7.70. If our club can get 5 members (or multiples of 5 members) who would like to own a copy of this great book, Ed can ship 5 books in the same box for a total of \$37.49 per book as opposed to \$44.95 if the books were shipped to each individual separately by standard priority mail. That's a savings of approx. \$7.50 per book. Here's the breakdown: 5 books @34.95, pus handling charge \$5.00, plus Flat Rate Postage \$7.70 = \$187.45 for each shipment of 5 books.

All our club groups continue to do well, and they all did a splendid job playing at our December meeting.


For 2005, the Fun Band and the Evening Ensemble will begin working on new music for performances this year. Practices will take place in a new location, to be announced.
